

The Bio-Medical Sciences Program is a six-week Summer and twenty-week Academic year - Enrichment Program funded by the William Penn Foundation. The program at Temple University offers 100 High School Students each year the opportunity to study mathematics, biology, chemistry, language arts and to explore careers in the bio-medical sciences. Eight colleges and universities in the Metropolitan Philadelphia area participate in the William Penn Foundation Program. Only the most committed University faculty and Philadelphia Public School teachers are asked to participate.
